#### Creative

Create a water safety poster based on the assembly that we had on Monday.

Use your watercolour skills to paint a local landscape. It could be in your garden or somewhere else like the park, a riverbank or out in the fields. If you don't have any paints, pencils are fine.

Draw a portrait of someone you find inspirational- you could share your creative masterpiece with this person and tell them why you have chosen them!

#### STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths)

Create your own symmetrical design like we have been working on in maths this week. Try challenging yourself to give your design two lines of symmetry instead of just one! Remember, a mirror can help you check your symmetry. You have some squared paper in your homework book.

Try making ice pops/lollies using different liquids - which one works the best?

Pick a country who are competing in the World Cup. Draw their flag and find out some interesting facts about it.

#### English Focus

Read a story to an adult and discuss what you have read.
