## History

Can you order some of the events of the Great Fire of London. Try to use adverbials of time e.g. first, then, next, after that, finally.

## P.E

Create a short dance with 3 movements to move like flames and smoke (E.g. dart, leap, twirl, sweep)

## Design and Technology

Design a chocolate bar with some tasty flavours. Draw a picture and label it. You could have a go at making it with an adult at home. E.g. your chocolate bar may have jelly beans and popcorn in. You could melt down a chocolate bar and mix in jelly beans and popcorn.

## English

Keep a diary for the week, try and write in the past tense, add in feeling words and use adverbials of time. e.g. first, then, next, after that, finally.

## RE

Tell us about how you celebrated new year. You could draw/print pictures, write a diary/list or tell a family member.

## Science

Find 10 items from around the house. Can you sort them into different groups based on their materials? In your books, you could write the names of your groups and list the items you have in each.
