

# **Curriculum Overview**

## English

We will be looking at stories from around the world at the beginning of term 3 in English , starting with Mufaro's Beautiful Daughters . We will then be reading Kensuke's Kingdom' where we will focus on reading and writing activities linked to the book.

#### Maths

In Maths we will start the term off by looking at the 11x and 12x table and the related division facts . We will then move on to long division , dividing a three digit number with a 1 and 2 digit number.

#### Science

Science this term will focus on the classification of living things that live in water and simple food chains. We will look at aquatic biomes and we will recognise that environments can change and that this can sometimes pose dangers to living things.

# Art

This term the children will do some observational drawings of different objects and begin to shade and use tone.

#### PSHE

Our theme this term is 'Dreams and Goals.' We will look at goal-setting, overcoming obstacles, seeking help and achieving goals.

#### Computing

This term in computing the children will be introduced to their own personal email account and the details of how to access it safely.

Internet safety will be taught regularly throughout this term.

# French

We will start the term learning about how the epiphany is celebrated in France and then move on to French phonics and some number revision.

## Music

We will be using Music Express to explore a unit of work about the Recycling. The children will be learning how to make music with paper and other recycled materials and will learn about Bhangra music.

# P.E.

In PE this term, the children will be doing gymnastics in the hall with TA Sport , concentrating on control, balance and sequencing.

On Thursdays they will be learning the rules and skills needed for

netball.

# R.E.

In RE, we will be exploring whether a holy journey is necessary for believers and to understand the difference between a pilgrimage and a holiday. They will learn about a range of places for pilgrimage in the Christian and Hindu religions.
