

# **Focused Homework Tasks**

Year 3 Homework is set on a Wednesday to be completed for the following Monday. Not all pieces of homework may need to be physically returned but please use your Home Learning books to record as you wish. You should choose one focused task a week.

R.	E

Can you describe one of Jesus' miracles and suggest how this could have authority over everyone?

Eg. A poster or storyboard

#### French

Children could revise the names of animals in French.

Can they make an illustrated shopping list of their favourite foods in French?

### History

\*Using library books or the internet, children could find out more about: The Stone Age /The Bronze Age/The Iron Age -They could produce a fact sheet about their findings.

\*Make a model of a pre-historic dwelling or have a go at making your own tools or weapons! But be careful :)

#### English

With a big focus on non-fiction texts this term, children could practice writing about a subject of their choiceusing non-fiction features e.g. Headings and subheadings, labels, bullet points, captions, lists, paragraphs and 'Did you Know' boxes.

#### Science

As we are studying fossils this term children could:

\* find out about Mary Anning or other famous palaeontologists.
\* Sketch or take photos of fossils of their own/seen in books.
\*Describe how fossils are formed with labelled diagrams.

## **Design & Technology**

We are looking at healthy sandwich fillings and lunchboxes this term.

 Children could research and explore different sandwich or wrap fillings that they have enjoyed eating and evaluate it for flavour, healthy ingredients and attractive presentation.
