You are expected to spend between 25 - 30 minutes on your Home Learning.

Music

In Music we will be looking at music from across the world. Compose your own piece of music and record it or take a photo of yourself.

Write a non-chronological report about something that interests you such as a hobby or a sport. Make sure you split it in to paragraphs and use subheadings.
